I wanted to die and now I had my wish, but I didn't want to be dead if it was like this! I couldn't see or move; I was just lying there in total darkness with overwhelming fear and loneliness. I cried out, "Please God don't let me be dead!" As I prayed, God quickly came and brought me out of the darkness. It was a miracle! I was alive again! I struggled to crawl out from under the truck. My head was split open and I had broken my back but I was happy to be alive. I urge anyone thinking of suicide to seek help. Trust me you do
